WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP?

Apprenticeships in Wales are open to anyone over the age of 16. They combine practical training in a job with study. You will gain hands-on work experience, learn new skills and gain a nationally recognised qualification. Apprenticeships allow you to earn while you learn.

As an apprentice you'll:

- work alongside experienced staff
- develop job specific skills
- earn a wage and get holiday pay
- get time to study (usually one day a week)
- boost your earning potential
- get a full package of support, whatever your needs
- have the opportunity for clear progression through the apprenticeship levels





It doesn't matter if you left school with a few qualifications, picked up a load of GCSEs, just finished college or graduated with a degree. There is an apprenticeship level to suit every individual.

Apprenticeship/Level	Equivalent educational level
Foundation Apprenticeship - Level 2	5 GCSEs / NVQ Level 2
Apprenticeship - Level 3	2 A-levels / NVQ Level 3
Higher Apprenticeship - Level 4/5	HNC / HND / Foundation Degree
Degree Apprenticeship - Level 6	Bachelor's degree

Apprenticeships are available in Welsh and bilingually. Allowing you to train and learn in your chosen language.
