




Click on Job Matching Quiz - '**Young People**' to access the Quiz.


Next, click the '**Sign Up**' box in the top right-hand corner of the page.


You can search Work Areas by either scrolling through the list or type into the search box.




If you click on the  icon you can save these work areas to My Plans which is in the ME section on the left hand side of the page.

After you have completed the first section of the Job Matching Quiz by clicking [MYFUTURE](#) you will see the following screen which gives you several options.



If a career is suggested that you feel is not for you, by going to the "Is this for me" section, you will be able to see the answers you gave to particular questions; and if you wish, you can change the answers to individual quiz questions here.
