

### **Transitional Planning**



- Transition planning means you planning for changes that will happen in your life as you get older.
- This may include what you want to do, where you want to live and the help you may need.
- To help you plan for these changes you will have a Transitional Planning Review -this is a meeting where you can say what you would like for the future
